Looking for more time for your child at Aldrich?

If you are finding that you need a little extra time to run errands or perhaps your child would be interested in another class at Aldrich, check out these options for children in the 3 & 4 year old classes:



- **EARLY BIRD** is offered on Tuesday and Thursday mornings only and allows an earlier start time for families who may need a more convenient drop off time. Children will be in Playroom 2 as early as 7:30am enjoying a relaxed atmosphere before their morning or full day session. Children are welcome to bring a small breakfast or a small snack will be served for those who don't pack their own.
- **LUNCH BUNCH** extends the morning or afternoon session just over an hour. Pack a lunch for your child, and then morning children can be picked up by 12:45pm or afternoon children can be dropped off starting at 11:35am. This year Lunch Bunch will be held in Playroom 1.
- **KIDS CLUB** extends the afternoon session by two hours so you can pick up your child by 5:30. Children will enjoy time in both playrooms, and weather permitting, on the playgrounds as well. Art activities, group story-time, and snack are also included in this popular option.
- **ENRICHMENT CLASSES** include options such as **Sports Adventures, Mini Scientists, Little Chefs, Bend and Boogie, Wacky Weather** and **Spy Kids**. These classes meet Tues/Wed afternoons from 1:00-3:30 for four weeks. If you are interested in enrolling, please stop by the office for more information or reference the fliers given out at orientation.

We encourage you to pick a day(s) for the year for Early Bird, Lunch Bunch & Kids Club, but some drop-in spots may be available as well. Enrollment forms for the enrichment classes are also on our website under the "Aldrich Families- Forms" tab. We hope that these classes will provide you with more options to find the right fit for your child and your family's needs.

Sports Adventures Enrichment Class starts soon!

Our **first 4 week Enrichment Class** of the school year begins October 2nd and 3rd! **Sport Adventures** provides great exercise in a structured format that introduces a wide variety of sports. It is about helping kids discover the champion within themselves, while emphasizing teamwork and fair play. We will introduce children to the basics of our world's most popular sports while building coordination, balance, and confidence!



Classes will begin on Tuesday, October 2nd and Wednesday, October 3rd and will run for 4 weeks from 1:00-3:30pm. (There may be options to extend the afternoon with either Lunch Bunch or Kids Club). Children must be at least 3 years old by Sept. 1, 2018 to participate in enrichment classes. The cost of this fun enrichment opportunity is \$75. Stop at the office by Friday, Sept. 28th to sign up!

Security at Aldrich



Aldrich has an intercom system at our main entrance similar to what is used in Rochester Public Schools. Visitors who come to school outside of the normal drop-off and pick-up times need to use the main entrance (door 16) which has a buzzer system with an intercom to the main office. All other doors will continue to be locked except at drop-off and pick-up times.

Safety First!

Children's safety is a primary concern of all Aldrich staff. We'd like to offer the following reminders:

In the parking lot:

- **Drive slowly – 5 miles per hour.** Children can dart out from cars so quickly.
- **Follow the directions of the one-way signs and arrows.**
- **Hold your child's hand** from the Aldrich door to your car door.
- Do not use cell phones while driving in the parking lot.
- Be considerate of other families and other cars.



When dropping off your child:

- **Please turn off your car.** For the safety of everyone in the parking lot, please do not leave your car running when dropping off and picking up children, even during the colder months.
- **Please bring all children into Aldrich with you.** If you regularly have a sleeping child in the car or too many kids to bring in with you, coordinate times with another Aldrich parent to watch your kids while you come in.
- Upon entering and exiting the building, keep an eye out for any children who may be alone and near the doors. We don't want to accidentally let children outside unaccompanied by their parent or guardian. If you see a child slip through the door, please stop him or her. The child's parent will thank you!

Welcome Flags

Have you noticed all of the flags lining both of our entrances? We are very proud that we have families at Aldrich from a variety of different countries! No matter the language, children's play is universal, and children can play alongside or with each other, even if they speak different native languages.



If you don't see a flag representing your home country, please stop by the office and let us know. We want your child to be part of this great Aldrich tradition! We'll be happy to order another flag, and we'll invite you to write "Welcome" in your native language.

Birthday Treats

We are eager to cooperate with families on birthday or other celebrations. If you would like to bring a treat in to celebrate, please talk with your child's teacher to arrange a date and discuss an appropriate and reasonable snack to bring in to share. All food must be store bought and in its original package. Full size cupcakes, sheet cakes, etc. will not be served in the classroom.

Bill Pay & Mail Slots: Tuition Payments Made Easier

Looking for an easier way to pay your tuition? Consider using your bank's online bill pay system. If you haven't used bill pay before, contact your bank for details to get started. If you already use bill pay, add Aldrich as a new payee, put your child's name in the memo section, and make your payment. It's even easier if you set up a recurring payment.

TUITION IS DUE ON THE 1st OF EACH MONTH, and it takes about one week for your check to arrive, so please plan accordingly. Please remember that no tuition payment is due on May 1st. If you are using automatic bill pay, your last payment is due on April 1st. A \$20 late fee will be assessed if payment is not received by the 8th of the month.

PLEASE NOTE: We have two other convenient ways to drop off checks at school. We have a slot on the left side of our Information Center (located by the front office) where you can place tuition. We also have a mail slot outside of our building, to the left of the front doors, for checks dropped off after business hours. For security reasons, always bring cash payments to the front desk. Thank you!


