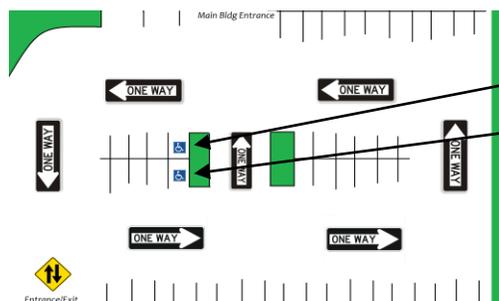
Caution: Parking Lot May Be Slippery!

SUMMER CAMP 2019

We are excited to announce that Summer Camps will be returning to Aldrich this summer! Summer program information is being distributed in your child's cubby beginning Monday, March 4th. This summer our summer camps will run Monday through Thursday from 9:00am to 11:30am.

Plan a week with some current Aldrich friends, or bring some neighborhood friends to these one week classes! In June through mid-July, we offer six separate weeks of morning camps for two different age groups.

3 year old classes:

- Monday through Thursday from 9:00-11:30 a.m.
- \$75 per week
- Children should have attended the Aldrich 2 year old program in 2018-2019
- OR Children must be 3 by June 1, 2019 and have previous group experience

4 & 5 year old classes:

- Monday through Thursday from 9:00-11:30 a.m.
- \$75 per week
- Children should have attended the Aldrich 3 or 4 year old program in 2018-2019 school year and turned 3 by Sept. 1, 2018
- OR Children must be 4 by June 1, 2019 and have previous group experience

Each week is a different theme! This year's themes are:
