#### Welcome Flags

Have you noticed all of the flags lining our hallways? We are very proud that these represent families at Aldrich from a variety of different countries! #### Security at Aldrich

The doors are at Aldrich are only open during drop off and pick up times. In the morning, doors will open at 8:45am. If you arrive at the school outside of normal drop-off and pick-up times, you will need to use the main entrance (Door M by the flagpole). This door has a buzzer system with an intercom to the office.

#### Safety First!

Children's safety is a primary concern of all Aldrich staff. We'd like to offer the following reminders:



- Drive slowly 5 miles per hour. Children can dart out from cars so quickly.
- Follow the directions of the one-way signs and arrows.
- Hold your child's hand from the Aldrich door to your car door.
- Do not use cell phones while driving in the parking lot.
- Be considerate of other families and other cars.

#### When dropping off your child:

- <u>Please turn off your car</u>. Aldrich has an anti-idling policy: all vehicles must turn off their engines within the Aldrich parking lot as soon as possible to protect children from inhaling harmful car exhaust.
- <u>Please bring all children into Aldrich with you.</u> If you regularly have a sleeping child in the car or too many kids to bring in with you, coordinate times with another Aldrich parent to watch your children in the parking lot while you come in.
- Upon entering and exiting the building, keep an eye out for any children who may be alone and near the doors. We don't want to accidentally let children outside unaccompanied by their parent or guardian. If you see a child leaving without an adult, please stop him or her. The child's parent will thank you!



### Help Keep Aldrich Healthy

While COVID has moved out of the spotlight in the news these days, it still remains a communicable illness in the world. As with all communicable diseases, parents play a vital role in in keeping our program open and healthy. The following guidelines are in place to keep the students and staff at Aldrich healthy and able to operate:

- All staff and students are strongly encouraged to be up to date on their COVID vaccination.
   Per the CDC: "Staying up to date with COVID-19 vaccinations is the leading public health strategy to prevent severe disease."
- All parents will be responsible to complete a daily health check of their child(ren) prior to
  arrival to ensure they are healthy. Children should only attend Aldrich if they are healthy and
  able to participate in all portions of the regularly scheduled day, including outdoor play. It is
  important to report <u>any</u> symptoms your child is experiencing to the Aldrich office within 24
  hours. If children exhibit any of the symptoms below, they should stay home.
  - Fever or feeling feverish/having chills
  - Cough
  - Sore throat
  - Vomiting/nausea
  - Diarrhea

Please be on guard and consider keeping your child home if they child exhibit any of the following symptoms, as they may be early signs of respiratory infections or communicable disease:

- Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Runny or stuffy nose
- Body aches
- Headache
- If your child is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (any symptoms listed above), COVID-19 testing is strongly encouraged. Free COVID Test Kits are available in the Aldrich office.
- If your child is exposed to someone that tested positive for COVID-19, we strongly encourage your child to wear a well-fitting face mask while at Aldrich, test if they become symptomatic or on Day 6 after exposure if no symptoms.
- If you receive a positive COVID test for your child, please notify the Aldrich office immediately by email at <a href="mailto:aldrich@aldrichschool.com">aldrich@aldrichschool.com</a> or calling 507-289-3097. This is vital so we can keep families notified of exposure. Children that test positive for COVID will need to complete a required isolation before returning to Aldrich.
- Aldrich will promote and practice frequent handwashing.
- Classroom windows will be opened when weather allows to promote better ventilation while indoors.
- Classroom surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected daily, with higher touch surfaces cleaned and sanitized more frequently based on use patterns.

We will continue to follow guidance from the CDC in regards to masking, isolation, testing and responding to outbreaks.

#### **Tuition Payments Made Easier**

Looking for the easiest way to pay your tuition? Here are our tuition payment options:

- Electronic Funds Transfer from checking or savings account To take advantage of this option, print off the form found at this link (or request a form from the front office):
   https://aldrichschool.com/wp-content/uploads/2023/02/Tuition-Express-NO-Credit-Card-2023.pdf
   and turn it in to the main office. Your tuition will then be automatically from your bank account on the first of every month.
- Bank Bill Pay System If you haven't used bill pay before, contact your bank for details to get started. If you already use bill pay, add Aldrich as a new payee, put your child's name in the memo section, and make your payment. It's even easier if you set up a recurring payment. Tuition is due on the 1st of the month, and it takes about one week for your check to arrive, so please plan accordingly. Please remember that no tuition payment is due on May 1st, which means that if you are using automatic bill pay, your last payment is due on April 1st.
- Personal Check Avoid the line at the front office by dropping your check in the secured Payment Slot on the left side of the Information Center (near the front office). Alternatively, you can drop the check in the mail slot outside the main entrance, to the left of the front doors, after business hours.
- Cash Payments For security reasons, always bring cash payments to the front desk.
- Credit Cards: Families may pay tuition with a credit card, but a 3% transaction fee will be charged. Please stop by the office if you would like to make payments this way.

Payments are always due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. A \$20 late fee will be assessed if payment is not received by the 8<sup>th</sup> of the month.




