Week 3	June 22-25	STOMP, CHOMP & ROAR!

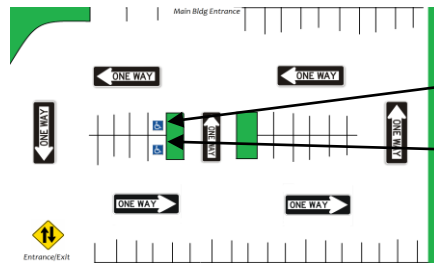


Here are some details about Summer Camp:

- Only children currently attending Aldrich for the 2025-2026 school year are eligible to attend.
- Summer Camp is \$150 per week.
- Summer Camp Enrollment forms will be sent home with families on Tuesday and Wednesday, March 10 & 11.
- **Enrollment for Summer Camp will begin on Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>.** As with enrollment, we will process in-person enrollments first. If you are unable to be here to enroll in-person on March 18<sup>th</sup>, you may email or drop off your enrollment form to the office in advance- those enrollments will be processed after we process in-person enrollments.
- Since we are only able to offer 3 weeks of Summer Camp this year, we anticipate spots will fill very quickly.

## Handicap Parking Spots

Did you know we have 2 Handicap Parking Stalls in our parking lot? The spots are located next to the trees near the center of our parking lot (see diagram below). Please leave those spots free for those who need them when dropping off or picking up.



## Plastic Bags in Cubbies

Please do not leave plastic bags in your child's cubby. Due to the safety hazard they pose to children, MN State Licensing prohibits children from having access to plastic bags while in our care. Since children spend time at their cubbies while under the care of our Aldrich teachers, open plastic bags cannot be left in their cubbies.



If you are looking for a safer alternative to transport wet/muddy outdoor gear home, we highly recommend using a reusable shopping bag. If you still prefer to use a plastic bag for this purpose, please knot the bag and put it in a zippered pocket of your child's bag/backpack. If teachers send soiled items home, they will knot the bag after placing the items inside so it cannot post a safety risk to the child. Thank you for helping keep our school as safe as can be!
